ADMINISTRATION OF EPINEPHRINE

Please read the following important points

If your child has a life threatening allergy and may require the administration of Epinephrine and/or Benadryl while at school, the **following forms are required**.

- 1.) Administration of Epinephrine for Life Threatening Allergic Reactions
 - Completed by the parent and physician
 - We will need a separate form for each medication being administered
- 2.) Allergy Action plan completed by the physician and the parent. Includes orders for administration of Benadryl and Epinephrine.
- 3.) If you would like your child to carry his/her Epi-pen, please check the appropriate box on the form for the Authorization for Self-Administration of the Medication on the Form

Medication will not be accepted in the nurse's office without the proper completion of the above forms. All medication must be in the original container. Epi pens should not be expired and have a prescription label which matches the doctor's order.
